

# Degree Progress Core Report

## TCU Core Curriculum

A range of 39-63 hours is required to satisfy the TCU Core. (Up to 24 hours can be "double-dipped.")

A maximum of two courses in the HMVV curriculum may be taken from one subject area (as defined by course prefix), e.g. the course prefix for economics is ECON. You cannot "double-dip" within the HMVV section. (18 hours)

### HUMAN EXPERIENCES & ENDEAVORS (HEE) (27 hours)

A maximum of two courses in the HEE curriculum may be taken from one subject area, as defined by course prefix. Additionally, Humanities, Social Sciences, and Natural Sciences must be fulfilled by taking at least two different subject areas, as defined by course prefix.

#### Humanities, 9 hours (HUM) (at least 2 different subject areas)


#### Social Sciences, 9 hours (SSC) (at least 2 different subject areas)


No course may count for more than one HMVV

#### Natural Sciences, 6 hours (NSC) (at least 2 different subject areas)


#### Fine Arts, 3 hours (FAR)


#### Alternative Overlay Course(s) (These are courses that fulfill HMVV, but not HEE.)

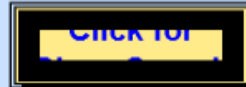
